





Strong Canadian dollar

Containers are purchased in US dollars and then sold in Canada in Canadian dollars.
Thus, prices are affected by the relationship between USD/CAD currencies, respectively.

Lower raw material costs

Fluctuations in the price of steel (used for containers) will affect a <u>containers' prices</u> (new and used) throughout the global market, but the cost of raw materials is generally low.





Canada's container export deficit

This has helped to reduce the cost of <u>shipping</u> <u>containers</u>. However, this may vary depending on the law of supply and demand.
